The tradition can be genuinely meaningful **and** the market around it can be full of fakes and false medical promises. Both are true at once. Wear a rudraksha with an open heart and open eyes.

# The seed & its story

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- **The name:** Rudra (Shiva) + aksha (eye/tear) = "the tear of Shiva." The Shiva Purana tells how the first trees grew where Shiva's tears fell.
- **What it really is:** the stony seed — the endocarp — of the fruit of *Elaeocarpus ganitrus*, a tall evergreen with a bright blue fruit. Not a gemstone, not manufactured.
- **The "faces" are botanical:** the vertical clefts (mukhi) are the seed's real internal compartments, not carvings — the single most important thing about a bead.
- **Three origins:** Nepal (large, deep lines, premium), Java/Indonesia (small, smooth, 70%+ of global supply, affordable), India (regional). All are genuine.
- **The sales myth:** "Java doesn't work" is a marketing line, not scripture — almost always said by someone selling Nepali beads.

### REALITY CHECK

Value and fraud both concentrate at the hand-sorting stage — where an ordinary bead and a rare one leave the same sack. Buy from sellers who name their source.

# Nepal, Java & India — compared

| ORIGIN           | CHARACTER                        | SIZE (MM)       |
|------------------|----------------------------------|-----------------|
| Nepal            | Large, deep well-separated lines | 14–40 (avg ~20) |
| Indonesia (Java) | Small, smooth, fine lines        | 2–20 (avg ~12)  |
| India            | Intermediate, regional supply    | varies          |

- Not fake, just different: the price gap between Nepali and Java comes from size, scarcity and line-definition — not authenticity.
- How a bead is made ready: harvest → de-pulp → sun-dry → hand-sort by mukhi count. That last step is where rare finds — and fraud — both enter the trade.

SOURCING RULE

Favour sellers who name their region — Arun Valley, Khandbari, a named Java estate. Vague "sacred grove" copy is marketing until it's backed by specifics.

# The mukhi system, 1–14

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Mukhi means "face" — the count of natural clefts, fixed by internal seed compartments. It drives both meaning and price. Deity/planet pairings below are tradition (Shiva Purana), not chemistry.

- 1-mukhi: Shiva, Sun — moksha. Round form exceedingly rare.
- 5-mukhi: Kalagni Rudra, Jupiter — peace, general well-being. The everyday, "safe for everyone" bead.
- 7-mukhi: Mahalakshmi, Saturn — wealth, abundance, relief from Shani dosha.
- 8-mukhi: Ganesha, Rahu — removal of obstacles, new ventures.
- 9–14 mukhi: lineages legitimately differ on the exact planet assigned — that's normal variation, not evidence of a fake.

## WHERE SOURCES DISAGREE

See the "varies" cases at 9, 11 and 14 mukhi. Be wary of anyone who insists their single attribution is the only correct one.

- Most abundant in nature — which makes it the cheapest and the honest default for a first bead.
- The 1-mukhi trap: a genuine round 1-mukhi sells for lakhs and is the most-faked bead in the world. The affordable "kaju" (half-moon) form is a different, honest bead — just not the round one.
- 15–21 mukhi: extremely rare, ₹24,000 into several lakhs — and exactly where fraud concentrates. Never buy on surface inspection alone.

A QUIET TEST OF ANY SELLER

If a shop's first pitch to a newcomer is an expensive high-mukhi bead instead of a plain 5-mukhi, be cautious — that's selling, not guiding.

## Special & joined forms

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- **Gauri-Shankar:** two beads naturally fused — read as the union of Shiva and Parvati. Rare, revered, and a top scam category via gluing.
- **Garbh Gauri:** a large bead with a small one naturally attached — mother-and-child imagery.
- **Ganesha:** a natural trunk-like protrusion — worn for removal of obstacles.
- **Trijuti:** three beads naturally joined (Brahma-Vishnu-Mahesh) — one of the rarest forms of all.
- **The rule:** every joined form is high-value, so every joined form is high-fraud. A glued fake shows a seam, filler, or texture mismatch at the join.

### THE ONLY REAL CHECK

Authenticity hinges on a continuous natural join with one shared surface skin — confirmed by X-ray of the internal structure, never by eye alone.

## Real vs fake

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- **Five common frauds:** carved lines on a cheap bead, gluing beads together, substitute seeds/wood/resin, plastic/resin molding, and resin- or lead-filled cavities to fake a "sink" test.
- **The water test proves nothing:** real beads can float or sink by density and trapped air; fakes are weighted to sink on cue.
- **The copper-coin test proves nothing:** any knobby round object pivots between two surfaces — simple mechanics, not "energy."
- **What eyes CAN do:** screen for continuous, unbroken ridge-lines and a rough, walnut-like surface. A flawless, mirror-shiny strand is a red flag.
- **What eyes CANNOT do:** confirm a costly bead. Industry estimates suggest up to ~60% of uncertified online beads may be adulterated or substituted.

### THE ONLY REAL PROOF

An X-ray or CT scan counts the internal chambers directly — that cannot be carved or glued into existence. For anything costing real money, it's non-negotiable.

WHERE SCAMS LIVE

Fraud clusters exactly where prices peak and buyers are most emotional. If a rare bead is priced like a common one, that's the scam — not a bargain.

## Malas & the 108

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- **Anatomy:** 108 counting beads + one meru (sumeru/guru) bead set apart, never counted, never crossed.
- **Why 108:** symbolic across Hinduism, Buddhism and yoga — Sun/Moon distance approximations, 54 Sanskrit letters  $\times 2$ , 108 nadis, 108 kleshas. Symbolism, not physics.
- **The one rule everyone agrees on:** never cross the meru. At it, pause, flip the mala, and count back the other way.
- **Materials:** rudraksha (Shiva, grounding), tulsi (Vishnu devotion), sandalwood (calming), gemstone (planet-matched).
- **Wrist vs neck:** neck mala (108) is for japa against the heart; wrist mala (27 or 54 + guru bead) is for daily presence.

### DEFINITION

Meru / sumeru bead — the still axis of the mala. You turn back at it; you never pass over it.

## Wearing & caring

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- **Threading:** silk/cotton thread is the most traditional; silver/gold caps are said to enhance. Either is fine — just thread gently so the seed doesn't crack.
- **Activation puja:** many "energise" a new bead on an auspicious day — lamp, water, sandalwood, chanting "Om Namah Shivaya" 108 times. Meaningful custom, not a measurable property.
- **Myths gently corrected:** no scripture says the bead is "destroyed" by non-veg food or alcohol; no scriptural bar on women wearing it, including during menstruation.
- **Care that actually preserves it:** keep it dry-ish, oil lightly (sandalwood/mustard/sesame oil), avoid harsh chemicals and heat, re-thread before the cord snaps.

### READ THIS FIRST

Everything labelled tradition here is custom and devotion, not physics or health law. Following it deepens meaning; skipping it does not "break" the bead.

## Health claims, checked against evidence

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- **The plain fact:** there is no robust clinical proof that wearing a rudraksha treats or cures any disease, lowers blood pressure, or "balances energy."
- **What actually exists:** a handful of small lab/animal studies on chemical extracts injected into animals — a different universe from a dried seed on a thread.
- **"Electromagnetic" claims:** marketing language borrowing physics vocabulary without physics evidence.
- **What a rudraksha genuinely is:** a devotional object, a real meditative anchor (focused breath + mantra has understood calming effects), and a heritage artifact — all worthwhile without a miracle claim.

### THE LINE YOU NEVER CROSS

A bead is not medicine. If you have hypertension, anxiety or any illness — keep your doctor and your prescriptions. A rudraksha may sit alongside treatment, never instead of it.

## Choosing yours

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- **The default for almost everyone:** a certified 5-mukhi bead or 108 mala, Nepali or Java, on silk/cotton thread. No horoscope, gender or age bar.
- **Four-step decision:** decide what it's for → set a budget as a filter against upselling → pick origin honestly (neither is "fake") → verify with X-ray for anything costly.
- **At the point of sale:** name the region, verify the certificate's serial on the lab's own site, and match the bead in hand to the certificate photos.
- **Run from a seller who:** diagnoses you, promises a cure, guarantees wealth, or pressures a costly "remedy."
